1. The Applicant is an adult Indian Inhabitant and is involved in the businesses of development of real estate and is having address as mentioned in the cause title of the present Application.
2. Being involved in the said business of development of real estate, Applicant is also full time or part time involved with various other persons who are in the same business as of the Applicant and are also associated with various Builders/Developers.
